



Top 10 North End Neighborhood Council Priorities

After months of receiving community input, holding a public forum and employing an online poll, the North End Neighborhood Council unanimously voted for the top 10 priorities in the summer of 2010 and requests the City of Tacoma implement these projects and projects as soon as possible.

- 1) Create a Community Garden Park at 16th and Junett
- 2) Permit neighborhood councils in to direct 1 percent of the Tacoma Public Works budget toward right-of-way projects.
- 3) Remove off street parking requirements for C1, C2 neighborhood commercial zones to allow businesses to flourish.
- 4) Create a Community center in the North End.
- 5) Build a streetcar line in the North End.
- 6) Place a crosswalk near Mason Middle School with flashing lights on Proctor.
- 7) Place more bulb-outs on arterial lanes in the North End.
- 8) Expand and highlight historic districts within the North End.
- 9) Bury all electrical wires in the North End.
- 10) Build a stage in the Old Town Park on 30th
